The LOVE banners were designed and created in 2008 by Lois MacGillivray, with the help of several women in the church. The smaller banners, which hang between the sanctuary windows, had a two-fold purpose; to remind us of what love looks like as found in **1 Corinthians 13**, and to bring an abundance of color into the sanctuary. The hope was that people might read the passage on the banner closest to where they sat and consider how that quality of love manifests itself in their lives that day or that week . . . or not.

The smaller banners led to larger banners on the chancel walls, which state the greatest commandments as love simplified to the finest and most basic way we are to relate to God and others, **love God with all your being, and love others as you love yourself.**

This whole set of banners is usually hung in the summer months. The smaller banners are sometimes hung at funerals as their words on love exemplify the character being honored.

Scripture:

Acts 1:1-12 NIV

Jesus Taken Up Into Heaven

In my former book, Theophilus, I wrote about all that Jesus began to do and to teach until the day he was taken up to heaven, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles he had chosen. After his suffering, he presented himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. He appeared to them over a period of forty days and spoke about the kingdom of God. On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

Then they gathered around him and asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?"

He said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight.

They were looking intently up into the sky as he was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them. "Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven."

Then the apostles returned to Jerusalem from the hill called the Mount of Olives, a Sabbath day's walk from the city.
