Genesis 17:1-5 NIV

When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to him and said, "I am God Almighty; walk before me faithfully and be blameless. Then I will make my covenant between me and you and will greatly increase your numbers." Abram fell facedown, and God said to him, As for me, this is my covenant with you: You will be the father of many nations. No longer will you be called Abram; Your name will be Abraham; for I have made you a father of many nations.

Genesis 26:2-4 NIV

The Lord appeared to Isaac and said, "Do not go down to Egypt; live in the land where I tell you to live. Stay in this land for a while, and I will be with you and will bless you. Pastor Gary Hicks served as the Outreach Pastor at Brook Hill for many years and had a heart for the poor. He was a gifted musician, preacher, and artist, a man of integrity and a Kingdom builder. He had a passion for the homeless and marginalized.

Beginning in June, on communion Sundays, we will take a special collection to help maintain this fund in order to continue to serve our neighbors in need in our community. An offering plate will be placed at the front to collect your donations in memory of Pastor Gary.
